ORDER:

In the Government order 1st read above Family Benefit Fund Scheme was introduced to the Village Servants w.e.f.1-8-80.

Consequent on the introduction of the Andhra Pradesh State Employees Group Insurance Scheme 1984, the Family Benefit Fund Scheme was abolished woth effect from 1st November1984. The Commissioner of Land Revenue after consulting some collectors and Village Servants association has recommended that the Andhra Pradesh State Employees Group Insurance Scheme 1984 may be extended to the village servants treating them as Class IV employees, though they are part time employees.

Government have examined the matter carefully and hereby extend the A.P. State employees Group Insurance Scheme to the village servants subject to the following modifications.

- 1. Each village servant shall contribute Rs.10/- p.m. till he attains the age of 60 years and he will be treated as belonging to Group 'D' of the Scheme. After completion of 60 years he may claim the savings fund portion with interest or at his option continue to contribute the savings fund subscription.
- 2. in the case of death of village servant before attaining the age of 60 years a sum of Rs.10,000/- shall be paid to the nominee of the deceased in addition to the balance in the savings fund as prescribed in the Government order second cited.
- 3. The Scheme shall take effect from 1st November,1987.

The procedure prescribed regarding the recovery of subscriptions, withdrawals and nominations in the Government order second cited the accounting procedure prescribed in the Government order 3rd cited shall be followed scrupulously.

The District Treasury Officers shall send to the Administrator of the scheme every month a separate statement of subscriptions of the village servants in the prescribed proforma.
