ORDER:-

The Sitting Members of the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council and associations of Ex-Legislators have represented the Government many times, requesting enhancement of the Medical reimbursement facility as the rates fixed in the earlier orders are outdated and not serving the purpose for which the medical reimbursement facility has been provided.

2) The Associations of the Ex-Legislators have also requested the Government to provide medical facilities to spouses of the deceased Ex-Legislators on par with the MLCs & MLAs, Ex.MLCs and Ex.MLAs.

3) The request of the Members and former Members were placed before the Amenities Committee, Telangana Legislature. The Amenities Committee under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Speaker, Telangana Legislative Assembly, made certain recommendations to the Government.

4) Government after careful examination of those recommendations and in supersession of earlier G.O.s on the subject, hereby orders that :-

- (1) The Telangana Legislators Health Scheme will be implemented under Arogyasree Health Care Trust for Legislators, Ex-Legislators and their dependent family members and also the spouses of the deceased Legislators and Ex-Legislators and their dependent family members.

(2) The Cashless treatment is extended for both OP and IP treatments on par with the rules applicable to All India Service (AIS) Officers and the procedures formulated under EHS will be followed in this regard.

(3) In case of Non cashless Treatments the medical reimbursement facility is extended on par with the All India Service Officers.

5. The Secretary, Telangana Legislature shall take necessary action accordingly .

6. This orders issue with the concurrence of Finance (EBS.V) Department vide their U.O.Note No.1555/182(A)/A.2/EBS.V M&H/2021, Dated 9-08-2021.
