In the G.O. 4th read above, Governmenthave enhanced the maximum ceiling limit from Rs.50,000/- to Rs.75,000/- to Governmentemployees / Retired employees and their dependants towards reimbursement of expenses incurred by them subject to the conditions specified therein.

The Cabinet Sub-Committee on services helddiscussions on various demands of the A.P. Secretariat Employees Coordination Committee on17-9-2001 including the above demand.

In the reference 5th read above, the A.P.Secretariat Employees Coordination Committee among other things, have represented to waivethe upper ceiling of Rs.75,000/- for Medical reimbursement in respect of major ailmentsrelating to Heart, Kidney and Cancer etc. In the reference 7th read above, the decision of the Government on the above demand has been communicated as mutually agreed to by theGovernment, and the representatives of A.P.

Secretariat Employees coordination Committeeon 18.9.2001. The Government and the A.P. Secretariat Employees Coordination committeehave mutually agreed to raise the ceiling from the existing Rs.75,000/- to Rs.1,00,000/-in case of Bypass Surgery, Kidney Transplantation, Neuro Surgery and Cancer subject tohowever, within the existing budgetary allocations.

Government after careful examination of the matter have decided that the maximum ceiling of Rs.75,000/- be raised to Rs.1,00,000/-for reimbursement of medical expenses for the treatment of Bypass Surgery, KidneyTransplantation, Cancer and Neuro Surgery only. this enhancement of limit should belimited to serving employees only and not to the pensioners. However, the existing limitof Rs.75,000/- be continued for the pensioners.

Accordingly, government hereby enhance themaximum ceiling limit from existing Rs.75,000/- to Rs.1,00,000/- for reimbursement of medical expenses for the treatment of Bypass Surgery, Kidney Transplantation, Cancer andNeuro-Surgery only limiting to the serving employees and their dependents. These orderswill not apply to the retired employees. Any expenditure in excess of the enhanced ceilinglimit shall however be borne by the Government Employees only. The procedure of requirement of referral letter by NIMS/SVIMS to obtain treatment in recognized privatehospital shall however be continued. This order will come into force with immediate effect.

This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide their U.O.No.5391/130/A2/2002, dated 27.2.2002.
