ORDER :

In the Government Orders 3rd and 4th read above, the schemes have been formulated for regularizations of the services of Daily Wage/NMR/Consolidated pay persons and Part-time employees and in the Government order first read above a scheme of compassionate appointments to the dependents of deceased Daily Wage/NMR employees etc., have approached various courts for compassionate appointments. The Courts are directed the Govt. to consider the cases of the petitioners for appointments on compassionate grounds treating them as a regular employees.

The Government have examined the matter. The benefit of compassionate Appointment is now not available under the rule to those who are not regular employees. The Government after careful examination of the matter, have decided to consider the cases of the dependents of the deceased Day Wage or NMR or consolidated Pay person or Contingent worker on full time basis or Part-time employees for compassionate appointment only in the following cases, namely:-

(i) If the deceased Day Wage or NMR or Consolidated Pay person or contingent worker on full time basis/Part-time basis was fully eligible for regularization under section 7 of the Andhra Pradesh (Regularizations of Appointment of Public Services and Rationalizing of Staff Pattern and Pay Structure) Act, 1994 read with G.O.Msa.No.212, Fin & P, (FW.PC.IM) Department, dated the 22nd April, 1994 and G.O.(P) No.112, Fin. & P, (FW.PC.III) Department, dated 23rd July, 1997 who could not be regularized due to administrative reasons, the case of dependents of only such deceased Daily Wage or N.M.R. or Consolidated pay person or Contingent worker can be considered for compassionate appointment from the date of issue of orders.

(2) While doing so, it has to be ensured that regular vacancy is available for deemed regularization of the deceased Daily Wage or N.M.R. Consolidated pay person or Contingent worker and appointment has to be considered without recourse to creation of supernumerary post; and

(3) This appointment of the dependent which is based on deemed regularization of the deceased person in terms of G.O.Ms.No.212. Fin.& Pig.(FW.PC.III) Department, dated 23rd July, 1997 as on the date of his death and therefore is shall nor confer any other benefits such as arrears of Salary, Family Pension and other benefits to the deceased employee or his/her dependents.

All Departments of Secretariat/Heads of Departments are requested to process the cases of compassionate appointment to the dependents of deceased Daily Wage or N.M.R. or Consolidated pay person or contingent worker on full time basis or part-time worker in pursuance of above scheme and obtain the clearance of the Government in Finance & Planning (FW.PC.IH) Department before order are issued for such appointment.
