In the G.O. first cited, Orders were issued imposing total ban on transfers of Government employees except when necessitated by disbandment of posts, reversions, retirements, promotions, repatriation, deputation and disciplinary proceedings.

In order to achieve the targets of the Government and to see that the welfare measures Government reach the public in the Backward & Tribal District of Adilabad, orders have been issued in the G.O. second cited relaxing the ban orders on transfers imposed in the G.O. first cited for effecting transfers within the Adilabad District and also for transfers from outside into Adilabad District. However these orders are confined only to the Adilabad District and no consequential transfers shall be made out of Adilabad District.

In the G.O. third cited, while relaxing the ban imposed on transfers in the G.O. first cited, orders have been issued that any transfer required in the interest of administration shall be effected between 10th May'1997 and 10th June'1997.

The District Collector in his letter fourth cited has brought to the notice of Government that with lifting of ban on transfers in the G.O. third cited, several District officers in Adilabad District are making efforts to get themselves transferred out of Adilabad District and therefore requested not to transfer any officer from Adilabad District without providing a suitable substitute.

All the Departments of Secretariat and all the Heads of Departments are therefore requested not to transfer any officer from Adilabad District without providing a suitable substitute.
