**LOANS AND ADVANCES** – Admissibility in Revised Pay Scales, 2010 – Recommendation of Pay Revision Commission 2010– Accepted – Orders – Issued.

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## **ORDER:**

In the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, based on the recommendations of Ninth Pay Revision Commission, orders were issued implementing the Revised Pay Scales, 2010 to the State Government employees.

- 2. The Ninth Pay Revision Commission, among others, has recommended the enhancement of eligibility ceiling for various existing advances for which Government employees are eligible as per Rules.
- 3. Government, after careful consideration of the recommendations of the Ninth Pay Revision Commission, and, in modification of the existing orders in Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, governing sanction of such advances to Government employees, hereby enhance the ceiling as recommended by the Ninth Pay Revision Commission, as follows:

<sup>4.</sup> In respect of all loans the penal interest will be charged at the double the rate of normal interest in case the advances are mis-utilized or not utilized at all and at  $1 \frac{1}{2} \%$  times the normal rates for non-compliance with formalities.

- 5. All other conditions governing the sanction of the above advances under the existing Rules/Orders will continue.
- 6. These orders shall come into force from **01-04-2010**.
