ORDER:

The Accountant General (A&E), Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad in the reference second cited has sought clarification from the Government whether Commutation of Pension can be allowed to the persons who retired from service as a measure of penality and admitted to Compulsory Retirement Pension under Rule 39 of Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1980.

A Central Government Servant Compulsorily retired from service as a measure of penality may be granted Compulsory Retirement Pension under Rule 40 of the Central Civil Services Pension Rules, 1972. Rule 17 and 18 of Central Civil Services (Commutation Pension) Rules, 1981 provide for commutation of pension to such Government Servant who have been admitted Compulsory Retirement Pension after Medical Examination.

Government have carefully examined the question of extending similar benefit to the State Government Employees receiving Compulsory Retirement Pension and have decided to adopt the aforesaid orders of Government of India. Accordingly Government hereby order that a Government Servant Compulsorily retired from service as a penalty and granted Compulsory retirement pension under Rule 39 of the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1980 may commute a fraction of Compulsory Retirement Pension as per rules in vogue after Medical Examination by the Competent Authority.

These orders shall come into force from the date of issue of these orders and shall apply to those who retired and granted Compulsory Retirement Pension on or after the date of this orders.

Necessary Amendments to the Andhra Pradesh Civil Pensions (Commutation) Rules, 1944 shall be issued separately.
