Attention of the District Panchayat officers in the State is invited. It is to inform that the Joint Secretary, MoDW&S, GoI informed that safe drinking water is a vital need of the people and it's important to address the problem of Drinking water, for which the following list of indicative works have been mentioned can be taken up under 14th FC grant.

- Providing pipe connections to rural Households
- Maintenance of damaged pipes, repair of tap connections, bore wells, purchase of spare parts under the operation and maintenance component.
- Providing safe drinking water to schools and anganwadi along with their maintenance.
- Ensuring sustainability through construction and augmentation of recharge pits, trenches, check dams, dug wells, skimming wells, traditional water bodies.
- Constructing community drinking water facilities.
- Providing community water purification plants in areas suffering from chemical or bacteriological communication.
- Capacity building of various village level.
- Payment of electricity charges for water supply schemes.

In view of the above, the District Panchayat officers are informed that the 14th Finance Commission grants can be utilized for the above works besides utilizing the grant as per the recommendations issued on 14th Finance Commission grants i.e. to strengthen the delivery of basic civic services including water supply, sanitation including septic management, sewage and solid waste management, storm water drainage, Maintenance of community assets and roads, footpaths, street lighting, burial and cremation grounds.
