**GUIDELINES TO TAKE UP THE SANITATION ACTIVITIES UNDER 13TH
FINANCE COMMISSION GRANT**

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- Sanitation should be taken up in a campaign mode once in a month in the Gram Panchayats
- Sanitation drive includes, cleaning of streets, de-silting of drains and garbage removal.
- The removed garbage should be dumped only at earmarked dumping yards. For locating the dumping yard suitable poramboke land may be identified away from habitations.
- Purchase of bleaching/ disinfection material should not exceed 5% of releases during the year.
- Salaries / Wages should not be paid. However, during campaign period the labour engaged extra may be paid from this fund.
- Major Gram Panchayats should follow solid waste management practices.
- Procuring of Tri-cycles for transport of garbage.
- Sanitation in Primary/ Anganwadi Schools.
- Construction of platforms to bore works.

The sanitation committee under TSC will supervise these wells.

The Extension Officer(PR&RD) should prepare plan in advance before a month so as to supervise the above programme and intimate the Gram Panchayats. Panchayat Secretary is sole respondent for implementation of the above programme.

All the District Panchayat Officers are requested to issue instructions to the field staff for preparation of action plan based on the above activities and to incur expenditure.
