Keeping in view of the Modified powers of technical sanction, the present work load and also for effective quality supervision, the modifications to the QC Manual & the Periodicity of the Quality Checks and QC Reports for Civil Works (Maintenance, Projects & others) is here by orders as follows:

Above 20.00 Lakhs – 3 reports and in addition one report for every 10.00 lakhs more	Up to 50.00 Lakhs -4 reports
	Above 50.00 Lakhs upto 2 crores- 4 reports and in addition one report for every 50.00 Lakhs
	Above 2 crore – minimum 8 reports with minimum 1 inspection for every fortnight
The Executive Engineer, Quality Control Cell should insist for ATR for adverse quality works where recovery and penalty is expected to exceed Rs.20,000/- The Executive Engineer incharge of the work shall not pass final bill without the confirmation of ATR by Executive Engineer, Quality Control Cell, MCH	a. In respect of recoveries / penalties less than 1% of value of work – The Executive Engineer incharge of the work shall submit a copy of recoveries / penalties statement to the office Superintending Engineer concerned (next higher authority) and also office of Superintending Engineer, Quality Control.
	b. In respect of recoveries / penalties more than 1% of value of work – The Executive Engineer incharge of the work shall get the approval of Action Taken Report from the Superintending Engineer concerned (next higher authority) and
