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#### ORDER:

In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Engineer–in-Chief, RWS&S Department, Hyderabad submitted the Contingency Action Plan-2015 for Rs.63.07 Crores and requested to release an amount of Rs.40.57 Crores to mitigate the drinking water problem in scarcity habitations of 9 districts in the State (except Hyderabad) in ensuing summer, 2015.

- 2. In the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Government have accorded administrative sanction to the Engineer-in-Chief, RWS&S Department for an amount of Rs.40.57 Crores (Rupees Forty Crores and Fifty Seven Lakhs only) from State Disaster Response Fund [SDRF] to mitigate the drinking water problem in scarcity habitations of 9 districts in the State during summer, 2015.
- 3. In the reference 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Finance (EBS.VII) Department has issued Budget Release Order for an amount of Rs.40,57,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Crores and Fifty Seven Lakhs only) Non- plan as additional funds in relaxation of Treasury Control and Quarterly Regulation Orders, pending provision of funds by way of obtaining Supplementary Grants during the financial year 2014- 15 to mitigate the drinking water problem in scarcity habitations in ensuing summer, 2015.
- 4. In the reference 5<sup>th</sup> read above, the Government released an amount of Rs.40,57,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Crores and Fifty Seven Lakhs only) from State Disaster Response Fund [SDRF] to the Engineer-in-Chief, RWS & S Department to mitigate the drinking water problem in scarcity habitations of 9 districts of the State in the ensuing summer, 2015.
- 5. In the reference 6<sup>th</sup> read above, the Engineer-In-Chief, RWS&S Dept., has requested to release the amount of Rs.40,57,00,000/- to the 9 District Collectors in the State.

- 9. All the District Collectors (except Hyderabad) in the State shall furnish the Utilization Certificates duly countersigned by the audit authorities to Revenue [DM-Accounts] Department and shall remit unspent balance, if any, to the Government account.
- 10. The Engineer-in-Chief, RWS&S Department, Hyderabad is also requested to submit the pending Utilization Certificates for the amounts, released earlier.
