ORDER:

In the references 1st to 4th read above, the Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, Hyderabad has requested to release an amount of Rs.51,92,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand only) towards input subsidy to the affected small/marginal farmers whose cotton crops was damaged more than 50% due to ‘Nilam Cyclone’ occurred during November, 2012 in Karimnagar District.

2. The Finance (EBS.VII) Dept., in the reference 5th read above, issued Budget Release Order (BRO) for an amount of Rs.51,92,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand only) Non-Plan as additional funds towards input subsidy to the affected farmers whose cotton crops were damaged due to ‘Nilam Cyclone’ occurred during November, 2012 in Karimnagar District in relaxation of Treasury Control and Quarterly Regulation Orders by way of obtaining supplementary grants during the year 2015-16 due to the budget released lapsed by 31.03.2016.

3. The Finance (EBS.VII) Dept., in the reference 6th read above, issued Budget Release Order (BRO) for an amount of Rs.51,92,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand only) Non-Plan as additional funds in relaxation of Treasury Control and Quarterly Regulation Orders by way of obtaining supplementary grants during the Financial Year 2016-17 towards meeting the expenditure for input subsidy to the affected Small/marginal farmers whose cotton crops were damaged more than 50% due to ‘Nilam Cyclone’ occurred during November, 2012 in Karimnagar District.

4. After careful examination of the matter, Government hereby release an amount Rs.51,92,000/- (Rupees Fifty One Lakhs Ninety Two Thousand only) to the Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, Telangana, Hyderabad, to meet the expenditure towards input subsidy to the affected small/marginal farmers whose cotton crops was damaged more than 50% due to “Nilam Cyclone’ occurred during November, 2012 in Karimnagar District. Subject to condition that:

- i. that payment of input subsidy will be done directly to the bank accounts of farmers which should be Aadhar linked as far as possible.
- ii. Payments shall be made within a period of 90 days from the date of release of funds.
- iii. Every farmer will be entitled for input subsidy for only one Disaster for the same agricultural season.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para (4) above shall be debited to the head of Account:

- MJH - 2245 - Relief on account of Natural Calamities
- SMJH - 02 - Floods, Cyclones etc.,
- M.H 101 - Gratuitous Relief
- SH (09) - Supply of Seeds, Fertilizers and Agricultural Implements
- 310 - Grants - in - Aid
- 312 - Other Grants - in- Aid

6. The Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, Telangana, Hyderabad, is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para (4) above and arrange to disburse/distribute the same to the affected farmers through transfer to bank account by way of cheques/ECS and utilize the funds for the purpose for which it is sanctioned.

7. The Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, Telangana, Hyderabad, is directed to furnish the distribution particulars to the Government as well as Director of State Audit, Hyderabad, Telangana urgently.

8. The Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, Telangana, Hyderabad, is also directed to furnish the Consolidated Utilization Certificates for the amount sanctioned now duly verified by the Telangana State Audit Authorities. The Commissioner & Director of Agriculture, Hyderabad, shall remit back the unspent balances, if any, forthwith to Government Account.

9. The expenditure mentioned in para (4) above is sanctioned in relaxation of Treasury Control and Quarterly Regulation Orders pending obtaining supplementary grants during 2016-17.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance (EBS.VII) Dept., vide their U.O.No.5296/157/EBS-VII/Rev/2016, dt. 06.05.2016.
