**ORDER:**

In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Secretary to Government, Health, Medical & Family Welfare Department, Hyderabad has requested to accord administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.103,00,00,000/- towards procurement of 132 PSA plants together with maintenance contract of these PSA in 129 hospitals for a period of 3 years.

In the G.O. 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Finance (EBS-VII) Department have issued BRO for an amount of Rs.103,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred and Three Crores only) as additional funds towards procurement of 132 PSA plants together with maintenance contract of these PSA in 129 hospitals for a period of 3 years in relaxation of treasury control and quarterly regulation orders by way of obtaining supplementary estimates during the Financial year 2021-22, under Covid-19 Pandemic Scheme.

After careful examination of the matter, Government hereby sanction an amount of Rs.103,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Hundred and Three Crores only) to the Vice Chairman & Managing Director, Telangana State Industrial Infrastructure Corporation(TSIIC), Hyderabad towards procurement of 132 PSA plants together with maintenance contract of these PSA in 129 hospitals for a period of 3 years.
