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**ORDER:**

The State Government have issued orders vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above to lockdown the entire State of Telangana with immediate effect till 14<sup>th</sup> April, 2020, prescribing certain regulations and measures during the lockdown period. The Government have decided to provide relief assistance during the lockdown period by way of providing one time support of Rs.1500/- per family to all the food security cardholders in the state to meet the expenditure on other essential commodities such as dal, vegetables and salt etc.

2. In the reference 4<sup>th</sup> read above Finance (EBS-VII) Department have issued budget release order for an amount of Rs.1314.00 crores (Rupees One Thousand Three Hundred and Fourteen Crores) as additional funds in relaxation of treasury control and quarterly regulation order towards meeting the expenditure for essential commodities under SDRF, COVID-19.

3. In the reference 5<sup>th</sup> read above the commissioner Civil Supplies & VC and MD TSCSCL department has requested to release the funds of Rs. 1314.00 Crores and to issue administrative sanction on the above issue BRO for taking further necessary action.

4. After careful examination of the matter Government hereby release an amount of Rs.1314 Crores (Rupees One Thousand Three Hundred and Fourteen Crores) to meet the expenditure to provide relief assistance during the lockdown period by way of providing Rs.1500/- for purchase of essential commodities due to Covid-19 outbreak under SDRF.

5. The Expenditure accorded in Para (3) above shall be debited to the following Head of Account.
