ORDER:-

In the reference 1st read above, Government have issued orders delegating financial powers to the Municipal Commissioners to incur expenditure for sanction of works / contingent expenditure for a period of (6) months initially in view of COVID-19 and Monsoon related activities, under section 53(3) of the Telangana Municipal Act, 2019, subject to the condition that such contingent expenditure so incurred by the Municipal Council / Municipal Corporations shall be placed before the Council / Corporation, when it is convened, for information and the Municipal Commissioners shall follow the rules and procedure while incurring the above expenditure and said orders were extended upto March, 2022 vide G.Os. 2nd, 3rd & 4th read above. Subsequently, the Government issued orders vide 5th & 6th read above, specifying the administrative sanction powers of Municipal Commissioners and Councils in the State for all Municipal Corporations and other ULBs with one lakh and above population.

2. Accordingly, though the orders issued by the Government vide 5th & 6th read above are in operation, they do not cover the smaller ULBs with a population of up to one lakh.

3. In view of the above and in the circumstances reported by the Commissioner & Director of Municipal Administration, Hyderabad in the reference 7th read above, Government hereby empowers the all Municipal Commissioners / Councils with population of upto one lakh, with the financial powers to sanction works not exceeding upto Rs.5.00 Lakhs / exceeding Rs.5.00 Lakhs and not exceeding Rs.50.00 Lakhs per month, respectively.

4. The Municipal Commissioners should follow all the existing norms of procurement, as well as to place all such expenditure incurred by them, before the council in its subsequent meeting for information and record.

5. The Commissioner & Director of Municipal Administration, Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly.
